What Christ Followers Can Expect By Being In Union with Him-Pt.1

I. Hostility from Unbelievers—15:18-25

2 relationships that create an expectation of hostility due to being a Christ follower:

- 1. In order to be faithful, Christians must expect hostility due to their relationship with the world—vv.18-19
- i. By knowing the world hated Christ first—v.18
- ii. By knowing that Christians are chosen out of the world—v.19
- 2. In order to be faithful, Christians must expect hostility due to their relationship with God—vv.20-25
- i. By remembering that slaves of Christ will not be treated better than Christ—v.20
- ii. By remembering that those who are hostile do not know God—v.21
- iii. By remembering that hostility is provoked by guilt of sin—vv.22-24
- iv. By remembering that Scripture predicts the hostile treatment of God's people—v.25
