In Matthew 2:1-12, there are 3 activities of God that should cause everyone to assess their response to the birth of King Jesus:

I. God draws various people to the King—vv.1-2

(Num 24:17; Luke 2:29-32; Is 49:6; John 12:27-33; 1 Tim 2:1-6)

II. God fulfills all prophecies concerning the King—vv.3-8

(Mic 5:2-4; 2 Sam 5:2)

III. God guarantees the exaltation of the King—vv.9-12

(Ps 72:8-11; Matt 27:37; Acts 4:27-28; Ps 2:1-12; Rev 19:11-16)
