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1 Kings 18: The Exclusivity of God's Supremacy is Demonstrated through His Zealous Servants -Pt. 2

In 1 Kings 18, there are 3 ways to advance the exclusivity of God's supremacy:

I. By confronting those who promote idolatry—vv.1-19

1. Only in accordance with God's word—vv.1-2
2. Even if others' convictions are underdeveloped—vv.3-16
3. Especially when responsibility is blatantly refused—vv.17-19

II. By trusting in God's absolute greatness—vv.20-40

1. Which is manifest in the pathetic impotence of false gods—vv.20-29
2. Which is manifest in the unmatched power of Almighty God—vv.30-40

(Gen 32:28, 35:10; Ex 29:45-46; Dt 4:7-8, 23-24; Heb 12:28; Lev 9:24; 1 Chr 21:26; 2 Chr 7:1; Dt 13:1-5; Rom 1:16; Gal 1:6-9; 2 Cor 11:1-4; Col 2:8, 20-23; Heb 10:11-18; 2 Sam 7:28; 2 Cor 4:6; Ps 51:10; Dt 30:6)

III. By relying completely on God's strength—vv.41-46

(2 Cor 12:9; Php 4:13; Is 40:28-31)

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
