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**1 Kings 19: The Abundance of God's Preservation is

(Is 55:8-9; Rom 11:33)

*In 1 Kings 19, there are 3 reassuring, continual activities of God
that help us persevere through our weakness:*

I. Amidst weakness, God continues to grant us our needs—vv.1-8

(Php 4:6-7; 1 Pet 5:6-7; Ps 56:3-4, 34:8-10; 145:17-20)

II. Amidst weakness, God continues to remind us of himself—vv.9-14

III. Amidst weakness, God continues to use us for ministry—vv.15-21

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
