(1 John 2:23, 5:9-10)

*3 recognitions which cultivate continual thankfulness to God
for his gospel work:*

I. Recognizing the foundational fruit of God’s gospel work–v.4

(2 Tim 1:13; Gal 5:5-6; 1 John 4:7-8; Eph 5:1-2)

II. Recognizing the imperishable basis of God’s gospel work– v.5a

(1 Thess 1:2-3, 5:8; 1 Pet 1:3-4; 1 John 3:2-3)

III. Recognizing the ordained means of God’s gospel work– vv.5b-8

i. Faith comes by hearing truth–vv.5b-6c

(1 Pet 5:9 (cf. John 12:19))

ii. Growth comes by true knowledge–vv.6d-f

iii. Salvation comes by faithful proclamation–vv.7-8
